The Challenge

In the next 10 years, it is estimated that 40% of insurance industry employees will retire, requiring skill sets in the areas of STEM, finance, marketing, investigation, and customer experience. In Michigan, the opportunity for a career in insurance is growing and it is imperative that we attract young people to careers in the industry.

The Response

A coalition was formed in 2014 called “Insuring MI Future” to support and promote opportunities for young people to pursue a great career in the insurance industry. In 2017, the Insuring MI Future Coalition received its 501c3 non-profit status.

Insuring MI Future activities include:

- Attracting young people to the insurance industry
- Supporting high school and college insurance programs
- Speakers for the classroom, career fairs and educator conferences
- Innovative high school program allowing hands-on insurance experience and free college credit



The Goals

Students are *not* automatically attracted to a career in the insurance industry. Many are unaware of the variety of jobs and how well those jobs pay. Insuring MI Future plans to build on the public awareness campaign with the following:

- Creation of insurance career marketing campaign (video, social media messaging, website, etc)
- Sponsorship of regional events to introduce students to insurance careers
- Development of high school insurance programs
- Creation of structured insurance internship programs
- Development of relationships with colleges/universities to grow degree programs

The Coalition

Insuring MI Future is a 501c3 organization with a vision to inspire young people to consider the insurance industry as a career path. Coalition members currently are: Insurance Alliance of Michigan, Michigan Association of Insurance Agents, Lansing Economic Area Partnership (LEAP), Farm Bureau Insurance, Pioneer State Mutual Insurance Company, AF Group, State Farm Agent Mason Novess, and Insurance Educator Carol Breed.



AN INNOVATIVE HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM

Attracting Young People

With young people making decisions about their futures earlier and earlier, the insurance industry must focus recruiting efforts to younger students. The Insuring MI Future High School Leadership Academy connects secondary education institutions with insurance carriers and colleges/universities to provide nine free college credits to high school juniors and seniors who learn about insurance first-hand.

Up Close and Personal

Students attend the insurance leadership class for about two hours per day. The classroom is generally held at an insurance company headquarters. Students earn nine free college credits by studying insurance-specific curriculum. The students also receive high school credits during their time in the class. Along with the rigorous curriculum, students take field trips and host guest speakers to learn about the different aspects of the industry weekly.

From an uncertain future to a successful career in the insurance industry, Blayne White found his passion when he attended the first high school insurance leadership program in Michigan.

As a senior at Holt High School, Blayne wasn't sure of his path after high school.

He then learned about the Insurance Leadership Academy where the students attend insurance class two hours a day at a local insurance company and earn nine free college credits.

Blayne signed up for the class and never looked back. He was very successful in the insurance leadership program, studying the

Institutes' INS 21, 22 and 23 curriculum.

Blayne job shadowed and gained valuable relationships with insurance industry professionals.

After his senior year, Blayne enrolled at Olivet College to study Insurance and Risk Management, graduating in three years instead of four by using his nine free college credits. While at Olivet, he was an officer in the Gamma Iota Sigma Insurance Fraternity and President of the Student Government.

Blayne, as most insurance graduates, was offered several industry jobs, but started his career as an insurance underwriter. Recently, he left that position to become an independent insurance agent. “I'm very lucky to find a career path that allows me to build relationships and let my customers know that I will be there if they have a loss, to help rebuild their lives.”
