- Be accepted and enrolled as a full-time (12 hours or more per term) student with a major in an insurance based curriculum or in a business, marketing, or finance curriculum considering a career in the insurance industry.
- Submit confirmation of a cumulative GPA of a 3.0 or above (on a 4.0 scale) from graduating high school.
- Have an immediate family member (defined as spouse, parent, child, brother or sister, spouse's parent, child, brother or sister, grandparent and grandchild) working at an MAIA-member independent agency.
- Submit a 1,000-word essay on *the importance of the independent agent in today's electronic society*.
- Be accessible for either an on campus or phone interview with a three-person panel.
